causing the nut to get loose. It's hard to stop a loose nut behind the wheel but you can stop a loose prop nut from causing damage with regular inspections. Steve also says to make sure the wire feeding your servos is big enough to handle the power requirements of the servo & then some.

Tim 1 (Sparky) announced pylon racing dates at the club field of May 7th, August 6th, & October 15th. Tim will be looking for volunteers to help run those races so if you're available, let him know you can be there!

There is talk of replacing the aging runway mat with new material. There will be more information presented at the May 11th club meeting & a fund has been
