5 cups chopped fresh broccoli

½ cup raisins

¼ cup chopped red onion

½ cup sugar

3 Tbsp vinegar

1 cup mayonnaise

12 slices of bacon, cooked crisp and crumbled

½ cup sunflower kernels (sunflower seeds)

Shredded cheddar cheese, if desired

In a large salad bowl, combine broccoli, raisins, and onion.

In a small bowl, combine sugar, vinegar, and mayonnaise. Pour over broccoli mixture and toss to coat.

Refrigerate overnight (or at least 8 hours).

Just before serving: Sprinkle with bacon and sunflower seeds; toss to coat. Can add shredded cheddar cheese, if desired. Enjoy!
