#### **Pumpkin Crunch**

1 15 oz can pumpkin

2 tsp cinnamon

Newsletter:

1 ½ cups *Truvia* (if using regular sugar, use 3 cups)

1 can evaporated milk

2 eggs, slightly beaten

In large bowl, mix above ingredients together and spread in a 9" x13" pan.

Then sprinkle or sift 1 yellow cake mix over top of mixture in pan.

Slice 2 sticks of butter into approximately 1/8" slices and place evenly over top of cake mix.

Sprinkle 2 cups of chopped pecans over top of butter slices.

Bake at 350° for 45 to 50 minutes.

Remove from oven and let cool thoroughly before cutting. Enjoy!

#### **Sweet Potato Casserole**

3 lbs.sweet potatoes
½ cup packed brown sugar
1/3 cup soft butter
¼ tsp vanilla extract
¾ cup chopped pecans

salt and pepper to taste

1/4 tsp cinnamon

2 cups min marshmallows

Peal and quarter potatoes boil for 15 min or until fork tender

In large bowl mash potatoes blend in brown sugar, cinnamon, vanilla

and salt and pepper. Fold in  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the pecans and spread into a 9 x 13 pan.

Top with rest of pecans and marshmallows on top.

Bake at 375 for 25 min or until golden brown


## Interesting Bits...
